

## Frequently Asked Questions

*Below are answers to some of the more frequently asked questions regarding Grant Wood AEA's **College for Kids Summer Enrichment Program**. This document will be continuously updated.*

### **Who sponsors College for Kids?**

Grant Wood Area Education Agency has sponsored College for Kids for 36 years!

### **Why was my child nominated for College for Kids?**

Students are nominated for College for Kids by their school or homeschool based on academic performance (high standardized test scores or gifted education participation) or demonstrated fine arts abilities. All nominated students will have completed 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade by summer 2023. Full eligibility requirements can be found on our website.

### **When will online registration begin?**

**NEW 2023:** Online registration will begin at **3:30 p.m.** on **March 1.**

### **What are the dates of the 2023 College for Kids program?**

Session A: Tuesday, June 20 – Friday, June 30

Session B: Monday, July 10 – Thursday, July 20

### **Where will the 2023 College for Kids program be held?**

The 2023 College for Kids Summer Enrichment Program will be held on the campus of Coe College in Cedar Rapids.

### **How is the program structured?**

College for Kids offers two nine-day sessions. The program runs 8:30 a.m.-12:07 p.m. daily. During the nine-day program students participate in three (3) classes which meet daily for 67 minutes each.

Period One: 8:30-9:37

Period Two: 9:45-10:52

Period Three: 11:00-12:07

(An optional Early Bird class is also offered for an additional fee, 7:25-8:20.)

### **What is the cost of the College for Kids program?**

Per session tuition will be \$285/student.

The optional Early Bird class will be \$65/student per session.

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### **What is the Early Bird class?**

Early Bird classes are optional and are offered 7:45-8:20 a.m. Students have the option to select an Early Bird class when registering for classes, giving them a 4-class schedule each day, rather than a 3-class schedule! The Early Bird class fee is \$65.

### **Is financial assistance available for families?**

### **When will the Course Catalog be posted?**

The Course Catalog will be posted in mid-February.

### **What IS the Course Catalog?**

The Course Catalog is a full listing of all course titles and course descriptions students may choose from when registering for classes. The catalog will also indicate the periods, or class times each course is offered (i.e., Period 1, Period 2 or Period 3). Limited space is available per class period.

### **How many classes will my child participate in as part of the program?**

Each student takes three classes as a part of the program.

### **Can my child register for both sessions, Session A and Session B?**

Yes!

### **What is the average class size?**

We expect the average class size to be 12-14 students.
